
HELLO NEIGHBOR!



EVANSVILLE MUSEUM OF ARTS, HISTORY & SCIENCE 🔾

Housing a permanent collection of more than 30,000 objects, including fine and decorative art, as well as historic, anthropological, and natural history artifacts along with a 40-foot diameter domed screen with 360-degree digital projection featuring astronomy and science programming.

NEW HARMONY'S ATHENEUM

Historic New Harmony's Atheneum houses visitor information, the Museum Shop, and is the starting point for their guided walking tours of historic structures. In the Atheneum there are exhibits on the communal history of New Harmony, a large theater where an orientation film on the town is shown.

EVANSVILLE AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSEUM

Located in one of the nation's first housing projects, Lincoln Gardens was built in 1938 under President Roosevelt's New Deal Program and is now a museum celebrating the struggles, successes and experiences of the African American culture in Evansville over the past 80 years.

EVANSVILLE WARTIME MUSEUM

During WWII, our nation's military went into battle with airplanes, ships, tanks and munitions manufactured in Evansville, IN. Stop by to see and hear the world-changing story of our region.

REITZ HOME MUSEUM

24 BE YOU. HERE.

This Victorian House Museum is situated in the heart of Evansville's Downtown Historic Preservation District.

The Reitz Home was built in 1871 and is noted as one of the country's finest examples of French Second Empire architecture.

LYLES STATION

Lyles Station is honored to be a part of the SMITHSONIAN National Museum of African American History and Culture in Washington D.C!, spotlighting Lyles Station as a pioneer African American farming community still in existence today.



We love our history! Not only did we manufacture LST war ships in Evansville during WWII, but you can now tour the LST 325 Museum: one of only two World War II LST ships to be preserved in the United States!



CRESCENT CITY TATTOO MUSEUM

On display is a collection of Midwest-focused, early Americana folk art including tattooing design sheets, tattoo trunks, and ephemera from the dawn of electric tattooing starting in the 1900's through 1960s. This museum is a result of many years of research and collecting and is one of just 19 tattoo museums in the country.







